**Note for Readers:** As you know our deacon is retiring so readers will now have more responsibilities. The **first reader** should carry up the Book of the Gospels in the entrance procession. The reader should follow the altar servers in the procession. The reader is the last person in the procession before the priest(s). The reader should walk directly to the altar and place the Book of the Gospels on the altar, move back to the front or side of the altar, bow to the altar and return to his/her seat. The **first reader** also reads the intentions after the Creed. The **second reader** reads the psalm if the choir is not present or if John is not singing the psalm. Sometimes the choir sings only the response. If that is the case, the second reader should read the verses.
