On the evening of December 21 at 5:30 pm there will be a **Las Posadas** (The Inns) celebration at the Immaculate Conception Parish. Las Posadas is a popular Advent celebration in Latin America. It is traditionally celebrated for nine days before Christmas and has three main parts. It begins by praying the Rosary, then participants join Mary and Joseph on their journey to Bethlehem and their search for shelter. The evening concludes with food, fellowship and of course a pinata.
